Rider Qualification for EPRHA year end awards

1. Rider must be a member of EPRHA.
2. Points will be calculated on the horse/rider combination.
3. Horse rider combination must compete in three (3) out of four (4) EPRHA sponsored Jackpots.
4. Rider must volunteer at least one (1) hour at a jackpot or other EPRHA event in order to be eligible for a year end award. (gate, scribe, office, set up, clean up, etc.)
5. Points will be awarded based on the number of horses actually competing in the class. Example: Ten (10) Horses compete, 1st place will be awarded 10 points, 2nd place – 9 points, etc.
6. EPRHA will post the standings of each show on the EPRHA website in a timely manner.

EPRHA Youth Award Series

The award series will run from January 1st to October 31st. Youth members will be able to earn points by riding in and attending EPRHA Jackpots, attending NRHA horse shows, attending clinics, club meetings, youth meetings, volunteering, community service, fundraising, recruiting new members, and by submitting the EPRHA youth scholarship application. EPRHA Affiliate Shows

The EPRHA Regional Affiliate Qualifiers will receive a year end award.

The following shows will be used as qualifying shows for the NRHA Mountain Regional Affiliate Finals. If any show below changes we will let you know as soon as possible.

1. Larimer County Spring Show, Denver
2. Sagebrush Slide, Pueblo
3. Eastern Slope Slide, Castle Rock
4. RMRHA Summer Slide, Denver

REGIONAL AFFILIATE FINALS RIDER QUALIFICATION

1. For an affiliate to qualify a rider for a class, that specific class must be offered in at least three (3) circuit shows. There is no minimum or maximum number of shows that a rider must attend.
2. A rider may qualify in only one region and for only one affiliate.
3. The rider must be a member of their local affiliate and their National Association Affiliate where applicable at the time of competition for points to count toward regional finals qualifications.
4. The affiliate membership lists will be used to determine a rider's affiliate. Riders with membership in more than one (1) affiliate must declare to the NRHA office each year by July 1, the affiliate they plan to represent at the regional finals whether or not they have shown in more than one affiliate. A rider's designation will remain as declared until the NRHA office is notified of a change. Designations and changes received between July 1 and December 31 will apply to the following year.
5. Points are to be calculated on a one horse/one rider format.
6. Points will be awarded based on the number of horses actually competing in the class, i.e. if fifteen (15) horses compete, first place will be awarded 15 points, 2nd–14 points, etc. Points will be calculated on horses actually competing, excluding the horses entered but scratched. Zeros and no scores will not be awarded points.
7. The top ten (10) horse and rider combinations plus ties from each class offered in a circuit qualify for the regional affiliate finals. There will be no alternates, nor will substitutions be allowed.
8. The NRHA office will post the standings of each affiliate on the NRHA web site.
9. Those qualifying for the regional finals may only enter the championship classes for which they qualify.
10. Riders may not change horses for the regional finals.
