

EPRHA Youth Awards 2011

1. **Class Awards:** Class awards will be placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Each show is jackpotted.
 - A. 14-18 will be placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
 - B. 13 and under will be placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
 - C. Green Youth B (10 and under) will be placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
 - D. Class awards will be placed the same for Green youth A and Wee Ones. For these two classes all participants will be recognized and receive participation awards.

2. **Youth All-Around:** All-around awards will be awarded to the 14-18, 13 and under, and Green Youth B classes. Awards will be determined by the accumulation of points awarded based on NRHA youth point scale (Page 85 of the 2011 NRHA handbook). Points will be acquired by competing in the four EPRHA Latigo shows. The highest points accumulated for these four shows will determine the Youth All-Around for these classes.

3. **Youth Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded. The scholarship will be awarded based on the application and voted on by the current board of directors. All youth scholarship money will be kept in a separate interest bearing account until distributed to the winner.

Qualifications for 2011 EPRHA Youth Year-End Awards

The following are the guidelines to qualify and be eligible for year-end youth awards.

Mandatory Requirements:

1. Youth must be a member of EPRHA prior to competing in a youth class. Points will begin accumulation from the date membership is purchased.

2. A minimum of one hour of gate time at any of the four EPRHA Latigo shows is required. For youth competing in the lead-line and walk-trot classes, a parent or guardian can help, but the youth must be present at the show.

3. A minimum of four hours worked at any of the EPRHA approved fundraisers is required. Hours must be dated and signed by the Youth Director and turned in on the EPRHA Youth Participation/Service Form.

4. Must attend three of the 2011 EPRHA youth meetings.

5. Participation in any of the EPRHA approved community service projects*. A minimum of four hours is required. There is no maximum.

6. Must compete in two of the four EPRHA Latigo shows.

**NOTE: Community service will be waived for all youth under the age of nine years, but we encourage their participation in all projects.*
